RABBI ALLEN & REBBETZIN ALISA SCHWARTZ



On this special celebration of Ohab Zedek's 150th year, we are honored to pay tribute to our own Rebbetzin Alisa and Rabbi Allen Schwartz for their 36 years of leadership. Their devotion to each other, to our shul and the Jewish community serves as an inspiration for us all. As our shul grew, so did their family. Their six children have branched out well beyond the Upper West Side and are the source of great pride along with their grandchildren.

Rabbi Schwartz holds the Raymond J. Greenwald Chair of Jewish Studies at Yeshiva University. He has a large following across the globe listening to his shiurim on YUTorah.org. The Rabbi has taught both elementary school and high school and currently teaches at Manhattan Day School. He also serves on the board of Yeshivat Sha'alvim and North American Conference on Ethiopian Jewry and served over 10 years as the president of the West Side COJO.

Rabbi Schwartz has recently published several volumes of his new series Parashah Sheleimah (Vayikra is now available), in addition to his 4 Sons Hagaddah, and an annotated edition of Rabbi Elazar Rokeach's commentary to Sefer Mishle. A new book about to be released called You, God, and Me, analyzes the balance between our Divine and interpersonal relationships.

Alisa is a talented and enthusiastic teacher, giving kallah classes, both in a group setting and on an individual basis. She enjoys maintaining connections with her students long after classes are over. Alisa has given many shiurim over the years, and helps run the Women's Emunah and Amen Group and during the summer, she and the Rabbi have served on the educational staff of Camp Morasha and Mesorah. Alisa has been active in Emunah Women of America, Manhattan Day School PTA and Bikur Cholim of the West Side.

When Alisa looks back over the past 36 years, she says that she loves living in the city. It is a place that has a constant energy and a unique openness. She loves the fact that it is a community where no two people are quite the same. She enthuses that it has been a great place to raise a family. Alisa and the Rabbi's breadth of generosity, chesed, spirituality and friendship know no bounds. They have endeared themselves to so many in our community through their attention to young and old, through life cycle events and in times of happiness and sadness.

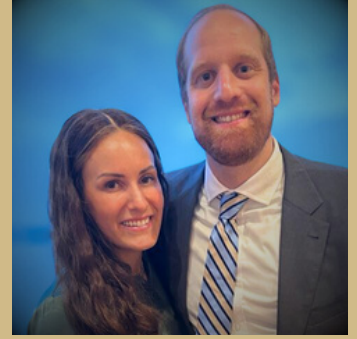

DRS. JOSEPH & RACHEL OFFENBACHER



The Offenbachers are relatively new members of OZ but have already made a big impact. They were introduced to the shul via Esther Varon soon after they moved to the Upper West Side in July 2022.

Rachel grew up in Woodmere, where she attended the Hebrew Academy of the Five Towns and Rockaways. She then went on to study at Shaalvim for Women in Israel. She earned her Doctor of Medicine in 2017 from at the State College of New York Downstate in 2017, graduating after completing the Sophie Davis School of Biomedical Education (a 7 year BS/MD program at CUNY). She completed her residency in Pediatrics and fellowship in Pediatric Hematology/Oncology at the Children's Hospital at Montefiore and recently joined the faculty as an Assistant Professor where she is on a physician-scientist track at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine.

In the summer, Rachel volunteers as a physician at Camp Simcha, where she has the pleasure of seeing many of her patients enjoy time away from the hospital.

Joseph (Joe) is from Brooklyn where he attended Yeshiva of Flatbush. He went on to spend a year at Yeshivat Reishit

Yerushalayim where he also volunteered as an EMT for Magen David Adom, followed by Yeshiva University where he Majored in Middle Eastern Studies.

After graduation he completed the one-year Presidential Fellowship in University and Community Leadership at YU followed by a post-baccalaureate at New York University before attending SUNY Downstate, graduating with Rachel. He completed his residency in Emergency Medicine at Montefiore Medical Center/Jacobi/Albert Einstein College of Medicine. He is a faculty member at NYU where he serves as an Associate Program Director of their EM program.

Rachel and Joe met through Yachad while they were both working as coordinators for the Rayim division. They were assigned to work together on a Shabbaton and the rest is history. They are the proud parents of Ari (12), Judah (8) and Asher (5).

Their meeting though Yachad set the tone for their marriage as Rachel and Joe have always been drawn to chesed within their community and beyond. Struck by the October 7th massacre, Joe quickly obtained an emergency medical license in Israel and boarded a plane to support his fellow physicians. He continues remote sessions while back in NY and returned in January for another two weeks in the emergency department. He founded the organization MiluiEM -- a partnership between the Israel Association of Emergency Medicine and emergency physicians across the world to bring

When asked by a close friend and pilot to raise money for his unit, Joe quickly agreed. Rachel and Joe delivered the equipment to the 669 unit in March, made possible by the generous donations of the OZ community.

DAVID & ELIZABETH SCHOEN



David and Elizabeth both joined OZ as new members in 1993 and met shortly afterwards at Rabbi and Rebbetzin Schwartz's home at a Shabbos meal for new members. They came to OZ with very different backgrounds--David was born in NY but grew up in Virginia while Elizabeth is from Montreal. Her father and grandfather were Orthodox rabbis while David grew up with little religious background. However after participating in a Turn Friday Night in Shabbos program run by OZ's then-assistant rabbi, Brian Thau, he was hooked and started attending the shul regularly.

Less than a year after meeting at the Schwartzs' table, the Schoens were married and a year after that, their first born son had his bris at OZ. The shul has played a central role in the Schoens' lives and Rabbi Schwartz has maintained his relationship with them ever since, even after they left the community in 1995 so that David could practice law in Alabama.

Today the Schoens live in Atlanta where they raised their five children who are the center of their lives. Their family was joined by a fabulous daughter in law, last year and more recently a granddaughter. Recently their son Arthur and daughter in law Chani moved to the Upper West Side and became members at OZ because of the family link.

Elizabeth is proud mom and bubbie to her children and grandchildren, and works within the Atlanta Jewish community as a loan intake and accounts manager at JIFLA- Jewish Interest-Free Loan Association of GA. Through the years, Elizabeth has been active in a number of Jewish Day school communities as a volunteer and administrator and has sat on the board of Beth Jacob Synagogue and the Yeshiva of Atlanta. Elizabeth holds degrees from McGill University and NYU.

David is a civil rights and criminal defense lawyer. He received his BA from George Washington University, has a JD from Boston College and a Master of Laws from Columbia University. His practice combines high-profile criminal defense work with civil rights cases involving fair housing, jails, voting rights, a voice for defenseless children and more. He's also taken cases pursuing terrorists for damages caused to Americans overseas.

David says he considers Rabbi Schwartz one of his closest friends, a true mentor and his religious advisor. The Schoens reach out to Rabbi Schwartz frequently for advice and with religious questions. Rabbi Schwartz personally calls each member of the family on her or his birthday.

The Schoens remain fond of OZ overall, and try to daven there when visiting New York. They are grateful to receive the alumni award this evening.

Message from The Rabbi



Alisa and I came to Ohab Zedek for the first time 36 years ago, on Parshat Hachodesh, with great anticipation for all the potential, in 1988, that lay ahead of us. I remember speaking that Shabbat about renewal, and “Hitchadshut”, and

our ability to rise up to meet any challenge if we do so united with each other and with Torah as our guide. We look back at these many years, and with similar excitement and enthusiasm, look forward to a continued bright future for our congregation and community. It is of no small significance that our dinner takes place on Rosh Chodesh, which exemplifies the essence of renewal.

We have had to, in our long history, renew our connection to our Temple, to Israel, and to Jerusalem, as we have never lost hope of regaining what was taken from us. These hopes imbued us with a sense of purpose. These hopes assured that we would return to Israel and successfully rebuild the Temple, that we would defeat the Greeks to renew the Temple in the Chanukah story, and that we would finally realize our daily prayers of a return to Zion and Jerusalem. This renewal is called a “Chanukah”, when we rededicate ourselves to our purpose as a people, which was to bring the light of God to the nations, even when we, like Avraham, stand alone.

These are tumultuous times for the Jewish people, but we all are inspired with a profound sense of purpose. The people protesting against us are angry, hateful, and vengeful, while

every study shows that Israel is one of the happiest places on Earth. Those who feel they are driven by purpose will always be happy. Ohab Zedek is profoundly blessed by everyone who enters our doors, and every one of them deserves recognition.

We give special recognition at this year's dinner to extraordinary people who have made great contributions to their people. Ilana Katz has deserved recognition for many years, and it is wonderful that public honor has finally caught up with her, as she is receiving our annual Schauer/Rosenbaum Gemilut Chesed Award. Her activism, and infectious friendly disposition spreads to everyone in shul. Joseph and Rachel Offenbacher, have in a relatively short time made a significant impact on their new community. They have stepped up to the plate to make a major impact for our people in these difficult times for Israel, and for this we are honored to bestow upon them the Nat K. Gross Community Service Award. David and Elizabeth Schoen, who have maintained a relationship with OZ since leaving the West Side over 20 years ago have continued to have an impact on our community all these years, and we are very pleased to honor them with this year's Alumni Award.
