A hundred year old building is bound to have a couple things to take care of...

In the coming weeks you will notice Congregation Ohab Zedek conducting different Spring Cleaning activities.

We apologize in advance for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience and support while we ensure great things continue to happen at OZ:

- Modernizing the office by storing and digitizing older financial records, and upgrading office technology due to grants and discounts awarded by TechSoup.
- Reorganizing our Cemetery Records (all members in good standing are entitled to a plot, contact the office for reservations).
- Installing Welcome Kiosks Tablets in the lobbies of the Bet Medrash and Office, allowing for easy access for Credit Card swiping, account information, and schedule details.
- Upgrading the Bet Medrash Electronic Zmanim Board.
- Reviewing the Seforim collection in the Bet Medrash.
- Creating new Tallis/Tefillin storage closet in the East Hallway of the Bet Medrash, (for members in good standing) as well as installing new storage cabinetry.

In addition to the above items, we will also be fixing a recurring steam pipe issue in the back and front of the Bet Medrash. This will require the dismantling of the back bookshelves and the pulling up of some flooring and carpet. Once complete, we will be creating storage closets for our extra tables and chairs (and clear the floor area and exits in the Bet Medrash).
