

On this special celebration of Ohab Zedek's 150th year, we are honored to pay tribute to our own Rebbetzin Alisa and Rabbi Allen Schwartz for their 36 years of leadership. Their devotion to each other, to our shul and the Jewish community serves as an inspiration for us all. As our shul grew, so did their family. Their six children have branched out well beyond the Upper West Side and are the source of great pride along with their grandchildren.



Rabbi Schwartz holds the Raymond J. Greenwald Chair of Jewish Studies at Yeshiva University. He has a large following across the globe listening to his shiurim on YUTorah.org. The Rabbi has taught both elementary school and high school and currently teaches at Manhattan Day School. He also serves on the board of Yeshivat Sha'alvim and North American Conference on Ethiopian Jewry and served over 10 years as the president of the West Side COJO.

Rabbi Schwartz has recently published several volumes of his new series Parashah Sheleimah (Vayikra is now available), in addition to his 4 Sons Hagaddah, and an annotated edition of Rabbi Elazar Rokeach's commentary to Sefer Mishle. A new book about to be released called You, God, and Me, analyzes the balance between our Divine and interpersonal relationships.

Alisa is a talented and enthusiastic teacher, giving kallah classes, both in a group setting and on an individual basis. She enjoys maintaining connections with her students long after classes are over. Alisa has given many shiurim over the years, and helps run the Women's Emunah and Amen Group and during the summer, she and the Rabbi have served on the educational staff of Camp Morasha and Mesorah. Alisa has been active in Emunah Women of America, Manhattan Day School PTA and Bikur Cholim of the West Side.

When Alisa looks back over the past 36 years, she says that she loves living in the city. It is a place that has a constant energy and a unique openness. She loves the fact that it is a community where no two people are quite the same. She enthuses that It has been a great place to raise a family. Alisa and the Rabbi's breadth of generosity, chesed, spirituality and friendship know no bounds. They have endeared themselves to so many in our community through their attention to young and old, through life cycle events and in times of happiness and sadness.
