We've been conducting services & sponsoring programs for over 80 years, servicing Fredericksburg, Culpeper, Manassas, Colonial Beach and Warrenton, as well as Spotsylvania, Stafford, King George, Orange, and Caroline Counties. Initially we met in homes, and then in 1940 we built our first building at 515 Charlotte Street, Fredericksburg. In the late 90's our growing communities required that we seek another home. A new, larger Temple was completed in late 2001 in the England Run area of Stafford County, Virginia. Over the years we have been served by full-time rabbis, student rabbis, and lay leadership. Regardless of leadership, we always provide a place of worship and community for the Fredericksburg area's Jews. Beth Sholom Temple is affiliated with the Union for Reform Judaism.
