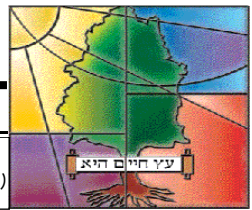

# Shabbos Parshas HaChodesh/Vayakhail-Pikudei March 21 2019/25 of Adar 5780

## Protocols and Zmanim for Davening B'vechidus (Individually)

### Fridav night:

#### Those making early Shabbos

Plag Hamincha is at 6:04 p.m.

Daven Mincha before 6:04 (plag) and light candles after that time.

#### Those making regular Shabbos

Regular Zeman for Candle lighting is at 7:01 p.m. Those accepting Shabbos at the zman should complete Mincha before 7:19 p.m.

### Shabbos Day:

· Netz Hachamah (sunrise) is at 7:09 a.m.

· Sof Zman Krias Shema is at 10:11 a.m.

· Sof Zman Tefilah is at 11:12 a.m.

· Mincha on Shabbos day should be recited after 1:45 p.m.

· Shkiah (sunset) on Shabbos day is at 7:20 PM. Mincha should be completed, and shaleshudes should be started, before that time.

· Shabbos concludes at 8:04 p.m. Maariv and Havdallah should not be recited before then.

### Davening Protocols for Shabbos:

· Certain parts of Tefilah are omitted when davening individually

Kaddish, Borchu, Chazaras ha-Shatz, and Kedusha are not recited when davening alone

### o Friday night:

One does say "Vayechulu" alone

Omit "Magen Avos" after the Shemoneh Esrei of Maariv

### o Shabbos day:

Omit Seder Hotza'as vehachnosas Sefer Torah, the two paragraphs of Yekum Purkan and Av Ha-Rachamim (since it is Shabbos Hachodesh/Mevarchim).

· Birchah Hachodesh is recited as this week is Shabbos Mevarchim. (Rosh Chodesh Nisan yihyeh b'yom Hachamishi (Thursday)) Note: The Molad will be Tuesday (morning) 10:14am and 11 Chalakim (Yerushalayim time) [it may be recited in English or Yiddish 😊]

· It's appropriate to read the Parsha (Vayakhel-Pekudei) from a Chumash, with the trop if possible. Similarly, the reading for Parshas HaChodesh (Shemos 12:1-20) should be read, as well as the Haftarah (Yechezkel 45:16-46:18). No berachos should be recited on the Torah reading or the Haftarah.
