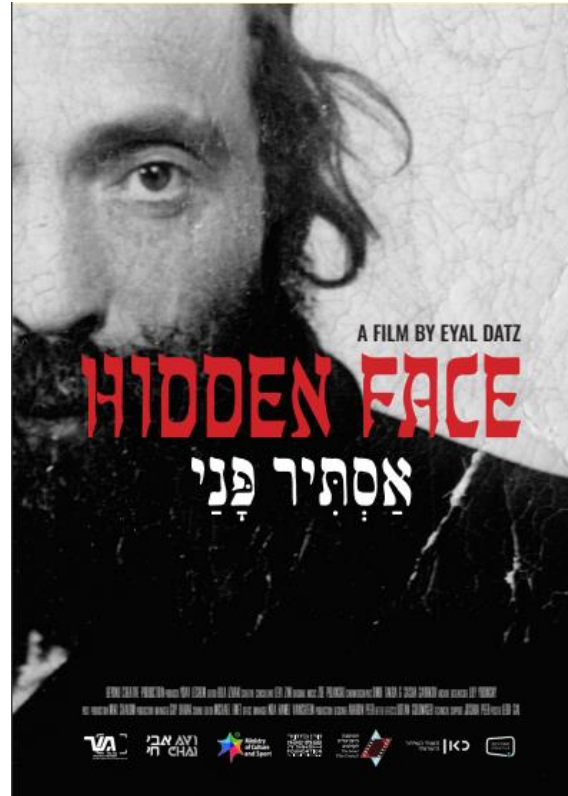
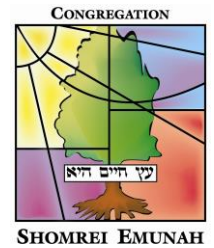

Through the *Admor of Sanz-Klausenburg's* heroic story, a man who experienced personal desolation and succeeded in rehabilitating his and his community's life, the film exposes the Holocaust stories as they're told in the *Chasidish* community. It presents the complex relations between the *Chasidish* community and the memory of the Holocaust and the ways they experience the revival and the spiritual victory over the Nazis.

We will also be privileged to hear from Dr. Baruch Schmidt and Shira Leibowitz Schmidt. Dr Schmidt came to Kiryat Sanz in 1980 at the behest of the Sanz-Klausenberger Rebbe, ztz"l. As the first Head of the Department of Surgery in the Laniado Hospital founded by the Rebbe, Dr. Schmidt enjoyed a multifaceted relationship with the Klausenberger Rebbe and will share with the audience a number of personal experiences.

Shira Leibowitz Schmidt is an author who together with Nobel Prize laureate Roald Hoffman co-authored, "Old Wine, New Flasks: Reflections on Science and Jewish Tradition." Her most recent publication is in Jewish Action, about "The Queen of Questions: Nechama Leibowitz, z"l," aunt of Shira's late husband.
