Sunday, April 21st – Search for the Leavened

Begin the search for the Chometz after 8:55 PM

Before beginning the search, one recites the bracha found in the front of the Haggadah. After the search is completed, there is a passage that is recited in the language that you best understand (“Any chometz which is in my possession...”).

It is important to designate and keep aside that which will you be eating on Monday morning from the rest of the chometz which is being sold, as the rest cannot be used and only that which is designated still for use may be used. Be careful to place the chometz that was found during the search in a paper bag and keep it near the front door so that it may be burned Friday morning.

Monday, April 22nd – Ta'anis Bechoros – Fast of the First Born

6:50 AM – Morning Services

7:40 AM Siyum for the First Born

10:00 AM – Final time to sell your chometz and give chometz bag to Rabbi Elie

10:34 AM – The latest time that one may eat any chometz that they kept aside for breakfast. From this point onward, no more chometz may be eaten. Any remaining chometz must be flushed down the toilet. After leaving the bathroom, say the second paragraph in the front of the Haggadah that begins with “Any Chometz which is in my possession...”.

10:30 AM – 11:30 AM – Community Chometz burning *at the Forest Hill Jewish Centre*

11:55 AM – If you are burning chometz yourself, this is the latest time to ensure that all chometz is burned.

Monday Night /1st Day of Pesach

7:52 PM – Candle Lighting/Mincha/Maariv. Halachic Seder begins not before 8:56 PM

Make certain that when you set up and light your candles, you also set up and light a 24-hour candle (such as a yahrzeit candle) that can be used to light the yom tov candles on Thursday night.

Tuesday/2nd Day of Pesach

8:57 PM – Ma'ariv & Candle Lighting for the 2nd Day (not before this time)

Set-up and light your yom tov candles from the previously lit 24-hour candle.

Make certain that when you set up and light your candles, you also set up and light a 24-hour candle (such as a yahrzeit candle) that can be used to light the yom tov candles on Shabbos night.

We begin the counting of the Omer at night at this point.

When setting up and lighting your yom tov candles, also set-up and light a 24-hour candle at this point to be able to light the candles for the last night of yom tov. Don't forget to count the Omer in the evenings.

Acharon Shel Pesach/Last Day of Pesach

9:06 PM – Regular Candle Lighting Time after this time

Light any necessary Yahrzeit Candles at this time from the previously lit 24-hour candle.

Tuesday, April 30th – Acharon Shel Pesach/Last Day of Pesach

9 AM – Shacharis with Yizkor

11:00 AM – Sermon sponsored by Jay Strasser & Family

11:45 AM Community Kiddush

5:30 PM – Mincha @ FHJC. Then, as a sign of *achdus*, our community will join Rabbi Deitsch for his epic Seudas HaMashiach.

9:07 PM – Havdallah

We make a special Havdallah at the end of Yom Tov only using a cup of wine and saying 2 blessings: one over the wine and one over the separation of the yom tov from the rest of the week.

The Chamtez that you put away and sold can be accessed again starting at 10:40 PM
