From Rabbi Goodman's Desk

Torah learning at the Beit Midrash of Forest Hill is in full-swing, and I want to let you know what's going on! There's a big variety of classes, shiurim, and one-on-one learning at the FHJC for men and women of all ages, nearly every day of the week.

On Sunday mornings, we study how the laws of Shabbat are relevant to modern day technologies, and we are about to start a unit on the use of electric devices. Our learning takes us from the Talmud to the Medieval commentaries, from the Code of Jewish Law to the vast Responsa literature, and the writings of the great Rabbis of the past century who have dealt with everything from incandescent light bulbs to automatic sensors. Breakfast from Bubby's Bagels is served!

On Tuesday mornings, we delve into the depths of Jewish philosophy with the great 18th century Kabbalist, Rabbi Moshe Chaim Luzzatto. His seminal work, Derech Hashem, addresses all the major topics in Jewish thought, including belief in Hashem, the nature of the soul, and the purpose of Torah and Mitzvos. We've just begun learning about the Purpose of Creation and why Hashem created the world.

And finally, we have our Night Kollel for men every Monday and Thursday night. A lot of people have already signed up to learn one-on-one with a chavrusa (study partner). Our study partners are learning a wide variety of topics, including Jewish history, Chumash, and Talmud. We have beginner, intermediate, and advanced learners all gathered together at the Centre twice a week to study Torah together, and I couldn't be more thrilled! If you've been thinking about engaging in deep Torah learning, this is a great way to get your feet wet! Aside from chavrusa learning, the Night Kollel also features a class on the Laws of Shabbat on Mondays, and a Talmud class on Thursdays.


