RABBI'S DESK

In this week's Torah portion, we are told about the 10 Commandments. If I took a poll, I'm not sure what people would say is the hardest commandment from the 10. I am sure many of you would say that Thou Shall Not Covert is a very difficult one, because who feels that their neighbour deserves more than they have? Perhaps Honouring Your Parents is very difficult; parents make demands, and sometimes as a child, you feel a little bit overwhelmed. However, I think the most difficult commandment is the First Commandment - I Am HaShem Your G-d. After all, if HaShem really is in charge, and He knows and sees everything, why wouldn't I comply and adhere to his standards of how I should behave? It must be that, deep down, I feel perhaps a little bit heretical, and maybe I don't believe in the One Above.

If I am right, then the key to successful living is not just the performance of The 10 Commandments; rather the key to open up all doors is to fully embrace the First Commandment! I recommend two great books that I think can get your Jewish muscles feeling stronger and stronger about the First Commandment. *Permission to Receive* and *Permission to Believe* are two outstanding books written by the same author, Rabbi Leib Keleman. These two books can do wonders, and once you fully embrace the First Commandment, the other Nine (in fact, all 613) Commandments become a piece of cake. And with that, you can all have a great Shabbos!
