RABBI'S DESK

As many of you know, I sit on the Beis Din for converts. My commitment is usually 3 hours every other week. We meet at the Agudah, and people come in and tell us their story. We listen to them, ask questions, and determine (among other things) if they are progressing or regressing, or if they are truly sincere. There is a lot of responsibility on this job. You, a finite human being, are deciding if someone should join the Jewish Nation. Other Beis Dins which help with divorce and financial disputes are also pretty serious, but here you are deciding the person's eternity. That's a long time.

I am writing this email in the parking lot of the Agudah where I just met with four more candidates. One was meeting us for the first time, the other 3 were coming for follow-up sessions. Yes, it's a serious job, and at many times I feel unqualified to decide a person's eternal fate, but I can tell you a few reasons why I love this job.

Firstly, I get to spend time with my Rebbi, Rabbi Lowy, and just sit at his feet and learn from him. Secondly, I get to be with Rabbis Vale, Azouli, Oziel and Plotkin. These Rabbanim would have been acquaintances but now they are friends. But most amazing is the fact that I get to meet people that are ready to change their lives to follow the truth.

Today, like many of the times I leave the Beis Din, I am in awe of most of the candidates, and wonder if I would have the courage and conviction had I been born in their situation.

May HaShem bless every Jew, and I pray the Jews by choice continue to enhance our holy congregation.


Adopt-a-Hostage
