# RABBI'S DESK

This week the Jewish People lost a Giant in Torah, Harav Matisyahu Salomon Z"L, the Mashgiach of the Lakewood Yeshiva (a "mashgiach" for a yeshiva is a Spiritual leader. Don't confuse this with the Rabbi who is in charge of food Kashrut, which we also call a "mashgiach". They are very different positions and roles). Rabbi Salomon grew up in England, and learnt and taught there, but ultimately was asked to lead the Lakewood Yeshiva in 1988. Personally, every time I heard him speak over the years, I felt it was my own Zaidy speaking to me. His wisdom and warmth drew you in, and his humility allowed you to be moved by his every word.

I saw a video by Rabbi Glatstein which touches on his greatness. When he was being honored by the yeshiva, he asked the crowd how he merited to be the "Mashgiach of Lakewood". He related that in 1941, during the Blitzkrieg in London, they needed one person to stay by a phone in a bunker over the 25 hours of Shabbos. They were hoping to get a call that the London Rescue Vaad would be able to save the great rabbi known the Svislovitzer Prodigy. That person was my mother.

Sure enough, that Rabbi, Rabbi Ahron Kotler, would survive the war and build the Lakewood Yeshiva in New Jersey after the Holocaust. Rav Matisyahu said "My award tonight is not my award. It's my mother's, Etil, who sacrificed so much for Rabbi Kotler and for so many others."

May his Memory be a blessing. *Rabbi Elie*
