FROM THE RABBI'S DESK

What's on Your Mind

Two points:

1. Wherever you are in life, there are opportunities to grow as a person. This past year, many people have lost loved ones or gained love ones. Some people were laid off and some people found jobs after being unemployed for a while. As outsiders to those people, we probably gave sound advice and felt proud of our insight and empathy. Well now we have a chance to take our own advice - what an opportunity!
2. Being quarantined or working from home means we have a lot of time on our hand.... Netflix must be real happy, but I, for one, am petrified. I always envision my Day of Reckoning in front of Hashem and I am always working on my excuses: I envision myself saying that I would have learnt more if I didn't have such a busy life; "If You, HaShem, had only given me 2 weeks of solitude in my house and told me not to socialize or run to a shiva house, I would have been your learning star! The FHJC asks people to observe the following protocols:

- If you have been indicated to self-isolate, **stay home**
- Individuals feeling ill or experiencing symptoms of the cold or flu **should stay home and, if necessary, seek medical attention.**
- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water, rubbing hands together with soap, lather for at least 20 seconds before rinsing.

- Please avoid hand-shaking, hugging, and kissing.
- Kissing of the Torah, Mezuzahs and Siddurim are activities that are being discouraged.
- Cover your cough or sneeze, preferably with a tissue that is immediately disposed of, or minimally, into your sleeve.
- Please wash your hands immediately after sneezing.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.

All these precautions are being undertaken with the safety of all community members in mind, first and foremost.
