We look forward to greeting you personally at the Forest Hill Jewish Centre this year. Below are a few important points to help keep you and your children safer this year during the Holidays.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS ABOUT CHILDREN:

Parents are reminded that they are responsible for their children while on shul property.

For their own safety, every child must be in a program or in a minyan with a parent.

Parents will be asked to reimburse the Centre for any damages caused by their child(ren)

Please be sure to check on your children regularly as the day is a long one, especially for young children. Children ages 0 to 3: we strongly suggest that at least one parent/caregiver remain with each child all times.

STROLLERS & CARRIAGES:

Strollers and carriages may be parked in the back of the building under the covered parking area. Due to fire codes and security policies, we are unable to host them in the building. Parents will be asked to ensure that either their young children are not asleep in their stroller or that they remove the child from the stroller. We strongly recommend the use of strollers with removable baby carriers/infant car seats.

NURSING ROOM:

A Nursing room can be found on the second floor at the end of the kid's classroom hallway, just behind the women's sanctuary entrance.

PARKING:

The parking at the rear of the Forest Hill Jewish Centre will be closed on Shabbos and all Holidays. The lane in front of the building will be closed off to all parking.

SEATING:

All non-plaque seats are open seating. Seats with a gold label are reserved seats. Please only occupy such a seat if it is yours. Ground floor—men's seating. Second and third floor balcony—women's seating.

BUILDING ACCESS & SECURITY:

General entrance and exit will only be through the front door. Access to the Centre requires a High Holiday Ticket. Please show your tickets as you enter.

Police, security guards and volunteer greeters will be stationed primarily at the front of the building. It is imperative that you follow their directions at all times for your safety and the safety of all attendees.

If you see something suspicious or out of place, bring it to the immediate attention of the our staff of security personnel. Failure to comply with our security policies or directives may result in you being denied entrance.

REMINDER:

Cellular or electronic devices are not permitted in the centre over the holidays.

We look forward to seeing all of you at the Centre, and wish you, your family, and all your loves ones a happy, healthy New Year and a very meaningful High Holiday experience.


