RABBI'S MESSAGE

Please join me in extending a Mazel Tov to Yosef Schwartz and his parents, Nuchem and Shoshana Schwartz, who are celebrating Yosef's Bar Mitzvah this Shabbos.

"And Noach Wavered"

Noach and his family entered the *teiva*. Why? Says the *Torah*...due to the rising waters of the flood.

The cause of their entering the ark is obvious, why must the *Torah* state it so explicitly?

Rashi strikingly suggests that it was only the rising waters that finally compelled *Noach* to act. Until that point, *Noach* was "*maamin v'eino maamin*" meaning, he was of two minds. He believed and simultaneously was skeptical about G-d's promise of the impending destructive flood.

How could one describe *Noach* as a wavering Believer if the *Torah* itself describes *Noach* as a perfectly righteous person?

The *Steipler Gaon*, cited by Rabbi Twersky, answers that there are two types of knowledge: Intellectual and Emotional. Intellectually, *Noach* understood that *Hashem's* promise of destruction was no empty threat. Yet, the human condition is such that intellectual awareness is often insufficient when making good choices.

We know that eating too much sugar, salt and fat is not good for us yet, for many, the temptation to fill our desire overcomes the intellect. I know that it is wrong to speak *lashon hara* and at the same time, I cannot seem to hold myself back. And a person might engage in risky behavior that he knows is not in his best interest but would never step inside a burning building to attain the same desire. The reason is because we experience the burning deep inside - not just intellectually but emotionally. The fear, in this case, would overcome the desire.

Noach had complete faith in *Hashem* and yet *Noach* hesitated. He believed (intellectually) and did not believe (emotionally), and that is where even complete faith becomes vulnerable.

Shabbos is a perfect time to reinforce both our intellectual reserves (*Torah*) and our emotional experience (*Teffilah and Oneg Shabbos*). In so doing, may we merit to lead lives of *emunah sheleimah*, complete and perfect faith.
