RABBI'S MESSAGE

Please join me in wishing a Mazel Tov to Avi (Avraham Yehuda) Schwartz and to his parents, Nuchem and Shoshana Schwartz, on the celebration of Avi's Bar Mitzvah this Shabbos.

Every Day is a New Day

The *Torah* describes the first *avodah* that the *Kohen* does each day with great flourish. "The *Kohen* shall don his fitted linen Tunic and he shall don linen pants on his flesh; he shall raise the ashes which the fire will consume of the *olah*-offering on the *Mizbeach*, and place it next to the *Mizbeach*. He shall remove his garments and shall wear other garments and shall remove the ashes to the outside of the camp - to a pure place."

The very first order of business is to get rid of yesterday's garbage. The *Kohen* was required to remove the burnt ashes (*Deshen*). Now, this was not simply a practical matter. This ritual required the *Kohen* to wear his priestly uniform and remove the ashes in a specific way - first placing the ashes next to the *Mizbeach*, and then removing the ashes to a pure place outside the camp.

What is the meaning of this seemingly mundane avodah?

R' Samson Raphael Hirsch suggests the *Torah* is teaching a critical life lesson. As the sun rises on a new day, we must cherish the fact that we have an opportunity, again, to get it right. Rather than rest on our laurels, we must clear the deck and start over fresh once again.

Says Rav Hirsch: "The thought of what has already been accomplished can be the death of that which is still to be accomplished.

Woe unto him who, with smug self-complacency, thinks he can rest on his laurels, on what he has already achieved, and who does not meet the task of every fresh day with full fresh devotion as if it were the first day of his life's work! Every trace of yesterday's sacrifice is to be removed from the hearth on the Mizbeach so that the service of the new day can be started on completely fresh ground."

We may also suggest that the *Deshen* ritual represents yesterday, with all its flaws and foibles. We must pick up yesterday's trash and jettison it from our minds. We cannot be held captive by yesterday's failures. By approaching each day with the optimism that this new opportunity offers, we have a chance at realizing its potential. If we carry yesterday's ashes into our new day, we condemn ourselves to repeat yesterday's problems and blinding ourselves to the beauty of today's possibilities.

This is indeed Holy Work; it's an *avodah* that enables the possibilities of all the other *avodahs*. The ash is holy because it represents yesterday's *avodah* in all its gore and glory.

Everyone has baggage. The question is, will we allow that baggage to define us or will we acknowledge it and then mindfully take it to a pure place outside the camp, precisely where it belongs.
