RABBI'S MESSAGE

A fool in deed is indeed a fool. How is it possible for a pompous fool like Bilaam to have the gift of prophecy, to communicate directly with Hashem?

Hazal teaches us that Bilaam did not earn his gift of prophecy through any merit of his own. Rather, it was because Hashem wanted to preempt the excuse, "The Jewish people had Moses as their prophet, but we had no one."

Therefore, Hashem gave them a prophet of comparable power in the person of Bilaam.

Rabbi Naftali Reich notes that the commentators focus on the word Vayekar used to describe the initiation of contact between Hashem and Bilaam. It is almost identical to the word Vayikra, which describes Hashem's contact with Moshe.

The difference in spelling between the words Vayekar and Vayikra is one aleph, and in the Torah that aleph appears in reduced size. Herein lies the key to the difference between Moshe and Bilaam. Explains Rabbi Reich, it is possible for two people to have the same experience, and yet, one will be deeply affected while the other remains indifferent. Everything depends on the mindset. Moshe was the quintessential humble man. Yet for all his wondrous prophetic powers, Balaam remains forever a fool.

In our own lives, we all experience moments of unusual transcendence from time to time, moments of intense inspiration that have the power to uplift our souls and effect in us lasting spiritual changes. Let us each be cognizant of those moments so that we are more spiritually enlightened and significantly altered for the better.
