RABBI'S MESSAGE

Purim 5784

Purim must be celebrated b'simchah – b'chol shanah v'shanah. Part of Haman's goal – and that of Hamas today – is to erase our unique nature, our hope, our emunah and our Yomim Tovim.

This year, we must celebrate with the appropriate joy and thanks to Hashem for saving us 'bayamim hahem' and 'bazman hazeh.'

That said, our celebration this year must be somewhat tempered. As Chayalim are still battling in Gaza, we must celebrate with that awareness.

Every family and each person needs to determine how best to express that sentiment on Purim.

Throughout Purim - a chag that calls us to be a united people - we should be thinking of and davening for Acheinu B'nei Yisrael.

Tips for Motzei Shabbos Purim

- One should not begin to prepare anything that is Purim-related before motzei Shabbos; items should not be brought to Shul for Shabbos mincha that will be used for motzei Shabbos.
- Baruch HaMavdil and Havdalah – those people coming from home to Shul should say Baruch HaMavdil before making any preparations. If they will be driving to Shul, they should ideally make Havdalah as well before coming to Shul motzei Shabbos.
- Havdalah is also recited in Shul after megillah reading.

This year, the Israel Advocacy Committee is offering you the opportunity to order matzah from Yedidya Harush who owns a matzah factory in Netivot, Israel. Yedidya Harush has served in Gaza and helping his business would be critically supportive during this time. This project is being coordinated by my colleague, Rabbi Daniel Cohen, Congregation Agudath Sholom, in Stamford, Connecticut.
