**Baruch Atah Adonai Elohenu Melech haolam asher kideshanu
bemitzvotav vetzivanu lehadlik ner shel Chanukah.**

Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the universe, who has sanctified us with His commandments, and commanded us to kindle the Chanukah light.

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה אֲדֹנָי אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם שֶׁעָשָׂה נִסִּים לְאַבוֹתֵינוּ
בַּיָּמִים הָהֵם בְּזִמַּן הַזֶּה.

**Baruch Atah Adonai Elohenu Melech Haolam sheasa nisim
laavotenu bayamim hahem bizman hazeh.**

Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the universe, who performed miracles for our forefathers in those days, at this time.

On the first night of Chanukah, (or the first time on Chanukah you perform this mitzvah), add the following blessing:

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה אֲדֹנָי אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם שֶׁהַחַיִּינוּ וְקִיַּמְנוּ
וְהִגִּיעָנוּ לְזִמַּן הַזֶּה.

**Ba-ruch A-tah Ado-nai E-lo-he-nu Me-lech Ha-olam
she-heche-ya-nu ve-ki-yi-ma-nu ve-higi-a-nu liz-man ha-zeh.**

Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the universe, who has granted us life, sustained us, and enabled us to reach this occasion.
