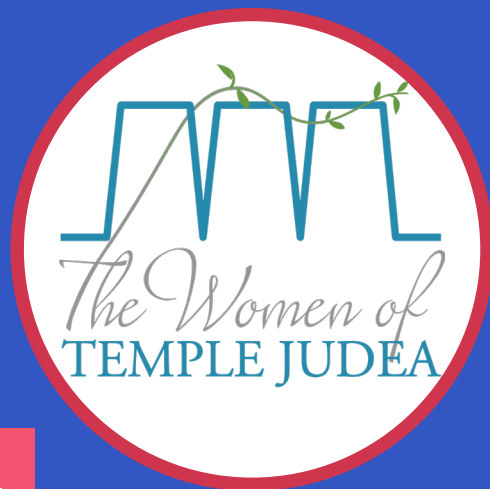


WTJ & The Miami Sisterhood Alliance need your help with a Virtual Food Drive to benefit the JCS Kosher Food Bank!
