So, what is J-PLEx?

The goal of J-PLEx (Jewish Play and Learning Experience) is to educate and enculturate young people so they will someday be adults who are committed to Judaism and its continuance, who identify strongly as Jews, and who participate as dedicated members of the Jewish community. Being educated at Temple Judea prepares our children to choose to practice Judaism out of love and respect for its traditions as well as out of knowledge of our values and ideals.

What ages is J-PLEx intended for?

We have amazing and special activities for every age group. From the age of 15 months to high school.

And for the families?

One Sunday morning a month we will kick-off the day with families in the sanctuary from 9:30-10:00AM for bagels, holiday celebrations (Sukkot, Simchat Torah, Hanukah, Purim, Passover and more) as an introduction to Jewish family life.
