I cried over loss and grief, over hope and celebration, over mistakes and triumphs, and it felt as if my heart was breaking. Passed the numb stage of mourning, I had spent days purging my office and packing up all my books and music (and the many owls!). Now I was moving into the real nitty gritty of loss. It is a necessary step in the grieving process. It had never occurred to me that I would have such a visceral reaction to leaving 7350 Lake Andrew Drive. I have always said that our congregation is the people not the building, but the building echoes the tears and laughter of so many. Its very walls reflect our longing and joy.

The Temple building is our foundation where God resides. In Kabbalistic teachings, a foundation is associated with our egos. Egos are necessary for us to live within this world. Our egos are the link between the God and this world. Our ego can help us to stand firm in this world, bringing our own point of view of life and living into our world with wisdom and vision.

There can be a dark side to the ego. An ego out of balance or not aware of the Divine Spirit within, can wield great destruction in our world. It is the foundation of our teachings that can help us to reign in a feisty, out of control ego. The ego needs to bend with the winds of change and be able to access the strength of the Indwelling Presence, the God within to accomplish its goals.

As I stood in the almost empty sanctuary my eyes moved to the doorway and the Chuppah disassembled lying on the floor. I had it placed in the doorway of our Sanctuary a number of years ago when David Huss, who had been the builder, gifted it to the Temple. People walk under the Tallit that is stretched out to make its roof. There are no walls, only a roof that speaks of the foundation of our beliefs. The Tallit represents the Mitzvot of the Torah and when we wear one, we are wrapped in Torah. A chuppah at a wedding is symbolic of the couple's home together. Within our sanctuary it has represented our Temple home and the open sides showing our desire to be an open and loving congregation. Our ego, our congregation's ego can learn a lesson from the chuppah. We can be flexible and strong, we can be open, yet also protected, as we cling to our Holy One of all Blessings. This is how we link our foundation to God.

I walked out of the Temple a little while later after my farewell to the sanctuary and looked across the parking lot at our beautiful new building rising from its foundations. The workers were applying the gorgeous stonework to the outside of the sanctuary wall and I felt a surge of joy in my heart as I looked to our future. Transitions are never easy and especially in the world we live in today, so filled with unknowns. But I know in my heart of hearts, that one day we will all stand together in our new sanctuary and dedicate it and thank the Never Ending, Always Beginning One for the chance to come together to celebrate and preserve the beauty of our traditions. I know that once again I will hear the laughter of our children as they sing the songs of our people. I can almost taste the delicious food our Women of Temple Israel will prepare in the new kitchen! And from my new office, I will be able to look across the parking lot and look at our former Temple home and know that God still dwells there, through the good graces of our Chabad friends. There is great hope for our future. From building, to building, to building we continue as God had promised Abraham all those years ago. What a wonder it is to have survived all those years and be brought to this holy moment.

## UNITED IN COMPASSION

Temple Israel is now officially part of an effort to feed the people in our community who are in great need at this time. United in Thanksgiving and Interfaith Affiliations of Brevard, of which I am a member, have created a special day called United in Compassion.

United in Compassion, an Interfaith Food Distribution Day will be held Tues. June 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Melbourne Auditorium parking lot beginning at 4pm. Beachside Hilton has donated the skills of their chef to cook 3200 servings of chicken parmesana and bread that will be distributed in a 2 serving container. We are expecting to serve approximately 800 cars/families. Inter Faith youth and leaders will be distributing them in a drive -thru manner where no one has to get out of their vehicles.

Participating Faith centers so far include: Islamic Society of Brevard, Eastminster Presbyterian, First Methodist Church, Shiloh Christian Center, Mosaic of Palm Bay, the Baha'i Center and Temple Israel.

Since this is an outgrowth of United in Thanksgiving, we are hoping the youth that spoke at our UIT events can be up front helping with distribution. ### President's Message for the June-July Newsletter

By the time you receive this newsletter, we will have moved out of our temple building. I would like to thank the temple staff as well as the volunteers who helped make this move possible. I would also like to thank Lynda Wilson for leading the Garage Sale that was held just before we moved out. We plan to move into the new temple building during the August to September timeframe consistent with completion of the construction and receiving a certificate of occupancy from the county.

As you will recall, we decided to move out of the temple building on June 1<sup>st</sup> rather than waiting until August so that we could experience some cost savings that would better allow us to withstand the financial impacts of the current coronavirus pandemic. During this period, we ask that our congregants continue to pay their dues as feasible and donations are always welcomed.

During the summer months, the temple staff will be working offsite planning for our move into the new building, planning the upcoming high holiday services and planning the reopening of the religious school. During this period, you can continue to reach the temple by calling our temple phone number or by mail.

The construction of the new building is moving along. The exterior walls, roof and windows have been installed; and work is continuing inside the building to complete the electrical and plumbing systems followed by the completion of the interior walls and floors. We would like to thank the Design Committee for their selection of the many interior and exterior design features that will make our new building a truly attractive place to meet and worship. We would also like to thank our Grant Committee for their efforts to prepare a grant application to build a playground at the rear of the new building.

Rabbi Pat has formed a committee to plan the high holiday services with special considerations being accommodating the impacts of the coronavirus as well as the schedule issues associated with completing the new building in a timely manner. In view of the upcoming high holidays, we ask that all congregants to please continue to support our High Holiday Appeal. More information about the holiday plans and the appeal are currently being prepared and will be distributed as they are finalized.

Once we move into the new building, we are planning an Open House Celebration. We are also planning to honor Rabbi Pat at a Gala Celebration. We are monitoring dates and options for these events based on Covid-19 conditions. If you haven't already done so, please make your reservations for the Gala and please support the Gala journal that is being planned for this wonderful event. More information can be found about the Gala and the journal in our weekly Shabbat to Shabbat publications.

On behalf of the Temple, I would like to wish all our congregants a safe and enjoyable summer season.




