

TEMPLE ISRAEL'S JEWISH NEWCOMERS PROGRAM

- **NEW MEMBERS BETWEEN AGES 18 - 30**
- **NEW MEMBERS WHO ENROLL CHILDREN IN RELIGIOUS SCHOOL**

1. Membership for new members between ages 18 - 30:

- a. Membership dues are waived during the first year. In lieu of membership dues, the new member will provide a minimum of 6 hours per month of volunteer time (or a donation of \$5.00 per volunteer hour) for the benefit of Temple Israel.
- b. In the new member's 2nd year, dues will be \$30.00 monthly (or \$360.00 annually) and a minimum of 6 hours per month of volunteer time (or a donation of \$5.00 per volunteer hour) for the benefit of Temple Israel.
- c. In the new member's 3rd year, dues will revert to the applicable membership categories (such as Single or Family, etc.), unless other arrangements are made with the Financial Secretary.

2. Membership for new members who enroll their children in Religious School:

- a. Membership dues are waived while Religious School is in session for the first year a child is enrolled, as long as the child's tuition is paid in full (or as prorated) by the end of the school year.
- b. During the school year, the new member family will provide a minimum of 6 hours per month of volunteer time (or a donation of \$5.00 per volunteer hour) for the benefit of Temple Israel.
- c. After the religious school year ends, membership dues will revert to the applicable membership categories (such as Single or Family, etc.) and pro-rated for the remainder of the Fiscal Year, unless other arrangements are made with the Financial Secretary.
