PARSHAT KI TAVO - פרשת כי תבוא

SHALOM AND WELCOME

PARSHAT KI TAVO - פרשת כי תבוא

בְּרִיךְ אֶתְּךָ אֱתָהּ, וּבְרִיךְ אֶתְּךָ בְּבֹאֶךָ; -- *Bless you in your coming, and bless you in your leaving.*

(Deuteronomy 28:6) The two traditional and popular understandings of the meaning of this verse are: 1) may you leave the world as innocent and pure as you entered it (*Midrash & Rashi*), and, 2) may your journeys to and from home be safe. But, neither of these understandings addresses the order of the words 'coming' and 'leaving.' That is, logically it makes more sense that one will be blessed first upon her leaving and then upon her coming. The scholar known as *Malbim* (d. Kiev 1879) explains that the verse speaks to the fact that most people who go out to work leave the home and its contents unguarded most of the day. When you leave the house in the morning, you know that things are in order and your belongings are present, but when you come home at the end of the day is when you learn if your home was burglarized, vandalized, or violated in any way. Thus, the sensible priority of first blessing is for your 'coming' back to your home at the end of the day. The second blessing for your 'leaving' is that your family members and livestock should be healthy as you leave home each day and that you shall be guarded from evil while away.
