PARSHAT NOACH - פרשת נח

PARSHAT NOACH - פרשת נח

Have you ever heard of the *Noahide* Laws?

1. Do not profane God's Oneness
2. Do not curse your Creator
3. Do not commit adultery
4. Do not eat from a live animal
5. Do not steal
6. Do not murder
7. Do not bear false witness

The Seven Laws of *Noah*, *שבע מצוות בני נח* - *Sheva Mitzvot B'nei Noah*, are a "set of imperatives which, according to the Talmud, were given by God as a binding set of laws to the children of Noah---that is, all of humanity (Sanhedrin 56a, Tosefta Avodah Zarah 8:4 and Genesis Rabbah 34:8).

We read in this week's *Parasha*, "God speaks to *Noah* and his children as they exit the ark: I now establish My **covenant** (*Brit* or **binding set of laws**) with you and your offspring to come... (*Genesis* 9:8-10)."

Let us be reminded that after people got out of control through lying, killing, and meanness, God destroyed the world, saving *Noah*, his family and the animals and then declared a **covenant** as a way of cleansing the new world.

Even though all of us humans make mistakes, we are reminded to keep to the morals and values we learn from God---*Shabbat Shalom!* שבת שלום (Saralee Shrell-Fox)
