ROSH HASHANAH - ראש השנה

בְּרֹאשׁ הַשָּׁנָה כָּל בְּאֵי הָעוֹלָם עוֹבְרִין לְפָנָיו כְּבָנֵי מְרוֹן – *On Rosh Hashanah the world's inhabitants pass before (God for judgment) like single-filed sheep (Mishna R.H. 1:2)* Our tradition teaches that God has a choice of two thrones to sit upon: one of strict judgment and one of compassion and mercy. Certainly we hope for God's greatest compassion during the High Holy Days – but how can we insure that God will sit upon that merciful throne? As we treat others, God will treat us. Accordingly it is taught, why did God fix the Day of Judgment to be in the month of *Tishrei* and not a different month? *Tishrei* falls after the late summer harvest whereby we are given the opportunity to provide produce to the needy. By placing Rosh Hashanah in the month of *Tishrei*, God invites us to move Her onto the throne of compassion by witnessing our own compassion for others. As we treat others, God will treat us.

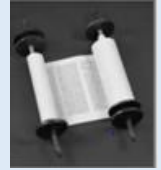

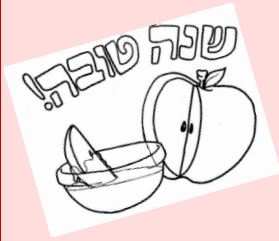
