**PARSHAT VAYELECH - פרשת וילך**

Three elements comprise the act of *Teshuvah*: 1) Recognizing the problem, 2) Requesting forgiveness for the transgression, and 3) Resolving not to commit the transgression again. For many of us, the act of asking others to forgive us is frighteningly difficult. Whereas in comparison it may seem easy to ask Gd to forgive our transgressions, to ask this of another person elicits true trembling. The Rambam teaches that 'reconciling not to commit the transgression again' can only truly be accomplished by having the exact same opportunity to transgress a second time and resisting only because the Torah tells you to – few of us get a real shot at this type of *teshuvah gemurah* (absolute repair). And yet, the most difficult step of all in the teshuvah process may be the initial, essential step of recognition of the problem. Were you to make a list of your transgressions this past year, how many items would be on it? Now answer this question: is it possible that you lived an entire year of existence, a year of interacting with others, a year of being subject to Divine expectations and your list of transgressions is complete?
