## SHALOM AND WELCOME

## 7<sup>th</sup> DAY PESACH - **שביעי של פסח**

*'And on the first day there shall be to you a holy convocation, and in the seventh day a holy convocation.'* (Exodus 12:16) This verse appears before the Israelite exodus from Egypt. It comes in the context of Gd telling Moshe about what to inform the people regarding the coming Pesach. According to our tradition, the Israelites crossed the Sea of Reeds, and the Egyptians drowned in that same sea, on the 7th day of Chag Pesach. The Talmud has Rabbi Yossi HaGalili teaching that the prohibition of chametz was only relevant on the first day of Pesach for the Israelites who fled Egypt. Thus, while still in Egypt the Israelites learn of the yom tov (holy convocation) status of the 7th day of Chag Pesach, even though it would only be relevant for future years and not that very year in which it was taught. The Meshech Chokhma (1843 -1926) teaches that this detail speaks of the perfection of Gd's mitzvot and their concomitant morality. He explains that the other nations celebrate the fall of their enemies, but Gd's will is that we do not rejoice in the destruction of our enemies. That is, if only after our liberation from Egypt we would have received the instruction that 7 th day Pesach is a yom tov, we may have understood the day as a celebration of the day the Egyptians drowned instead of what it truly is -- a celebration of our redemption from slavery.
