PARSHAT EIKEV - פרשת עקב

In this week's parasha, *Eikev*, we learn something extraordinary about Gd's providence during the 40 year trek in the desert. It is already known to us that Gd miraculously provided water, meat, manna and protection; this week we learn from *Your garment did not become worn with age upon you...these forty years.* (Devarim 8:4) The very clothes that the Israelites wore during their initial exodus from Egypt did not get worn out and deteriorate during the 40 year journey to the Land of Israel. On this verse, the commentary *Chesed L'Avraham* teaches that the soul, in contrast to the body, is eternal for it subsists entirely in the non-material. The desert generation of Israelites was a generation whose knowledge was so holy that even their clothes had sparks of holiness which allowed those clothes not to deteriorate. Knowledge, education, information is non-material and, thus, the only acquisition available to humans that is eternal – that is, which surely lasts a person's lifetime. It is no wonder that Judaism places such a high priority on education, as opposed to material possessions, as the former is soul-like and the latter is decaying/decadent. Rabbi Adam Frank
