**PARSHAT RE'EH - פרשת ראה**

The laws of kashrut are restated in this week's Parsha. Among these laws is instruction of what animals are permitted to be eaten as well as teaching that there is a particular slaughter that must precede the consumption of meat. In the face of growing concerns for animal welfare, much indignant ballyhoo has been made in the Jewish world claiming that Judaism teaches that eating meat is a mitzvah, that humans are supposed to eat meat, and that a diet which does not include meat is somehow un-Jewish. For the record, Judaism certainly permits the consumption of animal flesh. However, to those for whom the idea of a non-meat diet is anathema, the following quote from this week's Parasha and, more importantly, the Rashi commentary concomitant to the verse is as follows: *When Gd enlarges your territory as promised to you and you say, "I shall eat some meat," for you have the lust to eat meat, you may eat meat whenever you desire (Devarim 12:20).* Explains Rashi: *The Torah teaches proper behavior -- a person should not desire to eat meat unless that person is one who holds expansive possessions (enlarged territory) and affluence.* The Biblical verse speaks of meat as a desire and not an obligation. The normative rabbinic commentary goes even further by placing an accompanying judgment / qualifying rejoinder on the desire for meat
