PARSHAT TERUMAH - פרשת תרומה

וַיְדַבֵּר ה' אֶל מֹשֶׁה לֵאמֹר: דַּבֵּר אֶל בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל וַיִּקְחוּ לִי תְרוּמָה מֵאֵת כָּל אִישׁ אֲשֶׁר יִדְבְּנוּ לִבּוֹ תִקְחוּ אֶת תְּרוּמַתִּי
And Gd spoke to Moshe saying: 'Speak to the Children of Israel that they will bring for me a contribution; each person whose heart moves him will bring my contribution.' (Exodus 25:1, 2) This opening line of the weekly portion follows the previous portion called *Mishpatim* – Rules. Rabbi Mordechai HaKohen asks and answers the question, 'Why does this parasha, which is all about generosity of heart and giving, follow a parasha whose entirety is rules and laws governing human interaction?' Our tradition does so intentionally to emphasize and warn that a person who follows all the laws and who does not, and would not, bring harm to any others should not feel comfortable in the duties of his life. That is, one who does no harm to others, does not adequately reflect a life of Torah. Rather, one must also be active in generating good and bestowing help in the service of others.

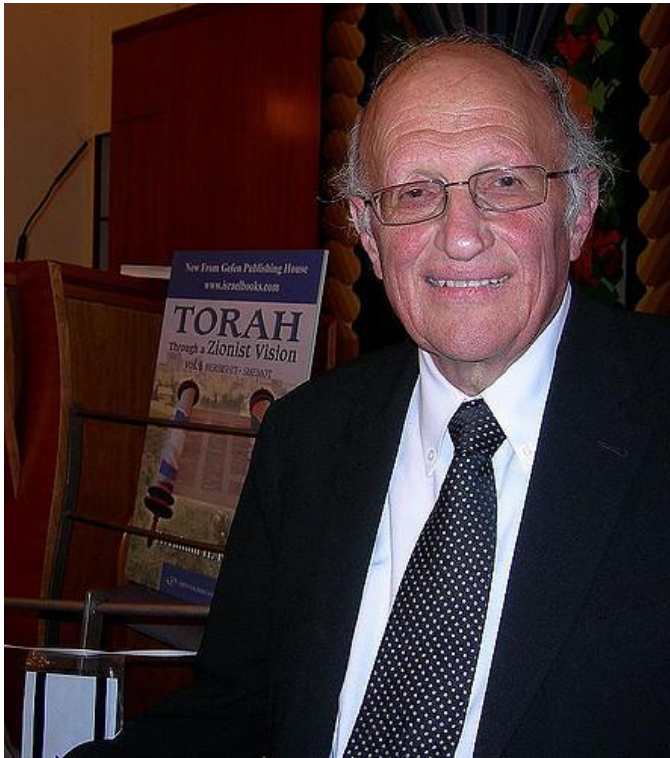

I have known Avraham since the days we both worked as regional directors of the United Synagogue, in addition to being rabbis in our respective synagogues (he in Toronto and I in Harrisburg) during the late 1960's. We resumed our friendship after his aliyah and was happy when he became the rabbi of our Moreshet Yisrael synagogue in 1993. Together, he and I were responsible for the daily morning minyan and whenever it was his turn to give a Dvar Torah or lead us in davening, we all were enlightened and inspired both by his words and his melodies.

Avraham was not only a rabbi, having received his ordination from JTS in New York, but he was also was a graduate of the JTS Cantorial school. His expertise not only lay in Judaica subjects and music, but also in secular subjects especially English Literature. He wrote many articles which were published in various journals and also authored several books in which he conveyed his Judaic and Zionist faith. From the minute I heard of his passing, I understood that it is not his family alone who have lost someone precious to them, but we too have become mourners as we appreciated him as a friend, a teacher, a hazan, a gentleman and Talmid Chacham.
