פרשת משפטים - PARSHAT MISHPATIM

The name of this week's Torah portion, *Mishpatim*, literally means 'Laws'. It is the first portion to follow the revelation of Gd at Mt. Sinai and its contents show starkly that the Torah, until now a narrative, is in fact to be the foundation of a legal code. A bizarre ritual is presented in the parashah's 6th verse, as it describes the ritual accompanying a slave's decision to stay in servitude to a master, rather than to go free. In short, the master is to place the slave's ear to a doorpost and then use an awl to pierce the slave's ear. How are we to understand this ritual? Has Gd instructed a procedure that is beyond our comprehension? The 11th century French commentator, Rashi, explains by quoting the words of the Talmud's Rabbi Yochanon ben Zakkai: "The ear that heard on Mount Sinai 'For to Me are the Children of Israel servants' (Leviticus 25:55) and he, nevertheless, went ahead and acquired a master for himself, should [have his ear] pierced!" And why is the doorpost specified as the place to do the piercing? Rashi continues: "The door and doorpost were witnesses in Egypt when I passed over the lintel (mezuzah)"...on the way to slaying the Firstborn of Egypt. The quandary of the intellectually curious reader is calmed by the beauty and logic of the tradition's commentary – a humbling reminder of appreciation for the scholarship and wisdom of our ancestors.
