PARSHAT KORACH - פרשת קרח

ויקהלו על-מנשה ועל-אהרן, ויאמרו אליהם רב-לכם--כי כל-העדה כלם קדושים, ובתוכם ה'; ומדוע תתנשאו, על-קהל ה'. וישמע מנשה, ויפל על-פניו. וידבר אל-קרח ואל-כל-עדתו...

And they (Korach & Co.) assembled against Moses and Aaron and said to them, 'Shame on you -- for all of the people are holy and Gd is among them -- why do you elevate yourselves above Gd's people?' And Moses heard and he prostrated himself. And he spoke to Korach and Co....

(Numbers 16:3-5) The Alter Rebbe of Lyady teaches: Moses could have immediately responded to Korach & Co. with his words; why does Moses first prostrate himself on the ground? Moses feared that Korach was simply a messenger and that in the heavens perhaps it was felt that Moses was acting elitist - when he falls to the ground he evaluates his actions and determines that there is no hubris associated with his fulfillment of his duties. At that moment, he understands that Korach is not agent of heaven, rather, he is an antagonist whom Moses must put in his place...and he does.
