PARSHAT BECHOKOTAI - פרשת בחוקותי

If you live with My statutes, and keep My commandments, and do them; then I will give your rains in their season, and the land shall yield her produce, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit. (Leviticus 26:4) Rashi teaches that to 'live with My statutes' means to study the statutes...the Torah. Thus, the verse promises us reward simply for laboring in the study of Torah. accordingly the Chofetz Chaim teaches that this statement speaks of the unique holiness and greatness of Torah. How so? Says the Chofetz Chaim - there really is no benefit or reward to one who toils in the world but does not complete a task. Even the artist who works endless days on a project - she will not be rewarded if she does not complete the work or at least have created something tangible from her labors. However, regarding Torah study, the toil of study in itself - not for the purpose of research or accomplishment or success in any way - in fact brings reward and benefit. It is no surprise then, that Judaism views Torah study as the direct engagement with Gd.
