PARASHAT R'EIH - פרשת ראה

ו כתוב: חג הסוכות תעשה לך שבועת ימים באספך מגרנך ומיקבך ושמחת בחגך אתה ובנך ובתך ועבדך ואמתך והלוי והגר והיתום והאלמנה אשר בשעריך (דברים ט"ז:ג-י"ד). אמר הקב"ה: ארבעה בני בית יש לך - בן, בתך, עבדך ואמתך - וכנגדם יש לי גם כן ארבעה - לוי, הגר, היתום והאלמנה. אם תשמרו את שלי עם שלך - מוטב, ואם לאו - תבוטל שמחה.

It is written: "After the ingathering from your threshing floor and your wine vat, you shall celebrate the holiday of Sukkot for seven days. You shall rejoice on your festival, with your son and your daughter, your manservant and handmaiden, and with the Levite, the stranger, the orphan and the widow within your gates (Deuteronomy 16:13-14)." The Holy One Blessed Be He says: "You have four members in your household - your son, your daughter, your manservant and your handmaiden - just as I have four members in mine - the Levite, the stranger, the orphan and the widow. If you teach care of my household with yours, all will be well; but if not, there will be no celebration, no rejoicing." - Pesikta Chadta

The midrash commenting on the 2 quartets juxtaposed in Deuteronomy 16:13 has God teaching us that there can be no true celebration in society, unless we also include the helpless, the homeless and the disenfranchised in our festivities. Only then do we fulfill the words of Deuteronomy 16:15 that follow - "And God will bless all your crops and all your undertakings, and you will have nothing but joy." Rabbi Moshe Silberschein

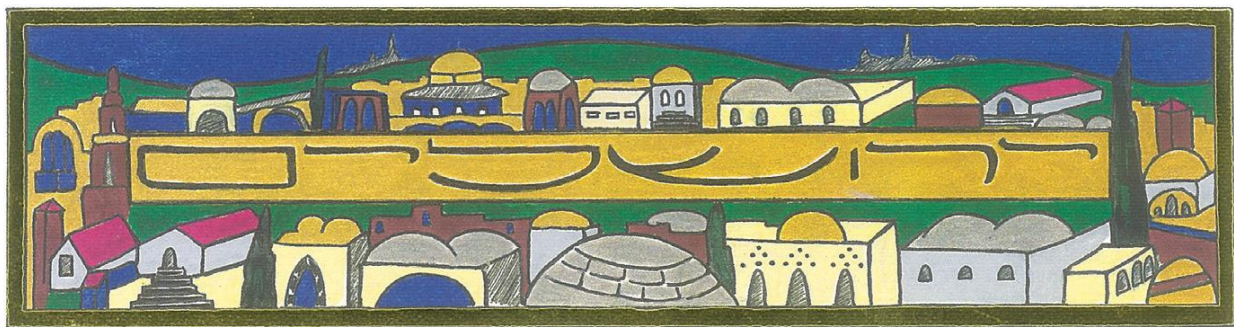
