PARSHAT PINCHAS - פרשת פינחס

"הלא אין פתיחת פרשה זו אלא סיומה של סוף הפרשה שלפניה, שבראשונה מסופר מעשה פינחס ובשנייה בא על שכרו, ולמה באו שתי פרשיות נפרדות? מה טעם לריווח בין הדבקים? - שאין ממהרים לשלם שכר קנאות. אם קנאי אתה, המתן נא מעט עד שיבדקו תחילה יפה יפה מעשיך אם אמנם כל כולם לשם שמיים בלבד, ללא פנייה ונגיעה אישית פרטית כל שהוא." (רבי משה מקוצי)

"Doesn't the beginning of this week's Parasha really belong at the end of last week's Parasha? The relating of Pinchas' zealous act is found in last week's Torah portion, but the reactions and rewards that Pinchas received for his action are only found in the beginning of this week's portion. Why are they related separately in two different portions? What is the reason for separating what clearly belongs together? Because one should not rush to approve and reward zealotry. If you have played the role of a zealot, don't expect any immediate reward or approval but wait until the community checks your actions very carefully, evaluating if all of your deeds were truly done only for the sake of Heaven, without any personal agenda whatsoever." (Rabbi Moshe of Coucy, 13th Century Ashkenaz)

Parshat Pinchas, according to Rabbi Moshe of Coucy, teaches us that might is not always in the right and zealotry must always be tempered by only the purest of motives. Rabbi Moshe Silberschein
