ROSH HASHANAH - ראש השנה

אחת ויעשו כולם אגודה אחת - And we will be bound together as a single unit.

These words come at the heart of the *Amida* prayers that we say on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Our rabbis ask, "How is it possible for all Jews to be as one unit?" It seems that Jewish unity was as elusive in 217 as it is in 2017. We Jews had to pray for it then just as we pray for it now. The prayer continues and gives the solution, לעשות רצונך בלבב שלם - by doing God's bidding with a whole heart. And to this the rabbis bring a parable emphasizing that the doing of God's bidding is contingent on our being a unit and doing it together. And in fact, it is only when we *do* God's bidding *together*, is God heralded as God

"Imagine", the midrash teaches, "that there is a palace. Half the palace is aboard one ship and the other is aboard a second ship. When then ships are docked one alongside the other, the palace is complete. However, when the ships set sail, if they sail together the palace is whole and royalty can descend upon it and rule. If the ships sail apart from one another, there is no place for royalty".

The lesson seems clear. In order for Jews to be as one integrated unit, we must do what we see and hear as God's bidding. We must do it together. Only when we do, can God come and be our royal.

I wish you, indeed I wish us all, that we set sail *together* during the time we spend praying, contemplating and musing during these Days of Awe.
