## SUKKOT - סוכות

We all know people who vary on the spectrum of Torah study and that of good deeds. Some study a lot but engage in little else. Some are so busy with good deeds that that have little time for study. Some, somehow, strike the balance between the two; sadly, there are those who make time for neither. The rabbis have a heated debate which is more important. R. Akiva settles the debate teaching that Torah study is paramount as it leads to good deeds. Would that this were always be the case!

Sukkot teaches us that no matter who we meet, our job is to become אגודה אחת – a single unit. They teach us through a parable (what's new?) of the Four Species. Each varies along the spectrum of - odour and טעם – taste. The willow has neither, the Hadass (myrtle) has a wonderful odour but no particular taste, the date palm, לולב has taste (of the dates) but no odour to speak of and the Etrog has both. The equivalence is to those people who vary on the spectra of Torah & good deeds.

Yet on Sukkot we gather them all together. We welcome all types under the canopy of the Sukkah. We hope & pray that the good qualities of each influence the others. Our goal is to try to overlook the misgivings we have about the other, not be too proud of what we do and move forward to a chag, and season of blessing and comfort.
