## PARSHAT KI TETZE - פרשת כי תצא

The following words open this week's Torah portion: *כִּי-תֵצֵא לְמִלְחָמָה, עַל-אֹיְבֶיךָ; וַיִּנְתְּנֵנוּ ה' אֱלֹהֶיךָ, בְּיָדְךָ -- When you go out to battle against your enemies, and Gd delivers them into your hands...*(Deuteronomy 21:10) Paradoxically, we read in the Book of Numbers (10:9): *And when war comes into your land against the adversary that oppresses you, then you shall sound an alarm with the trumpets; and you shall be remembered before Gd, and will be saved from your enemies.* Why does the reference to war in Numbers say we must beseech Gd for deliverance whereas this week's reading says Gd will deliver our enemies into our hands without our entreating? Says the Kotzker Rebbe that when you 'go out' to battle an enemy in his land you have great chance of winning; however, 'when war comes into your land' your enemy has launched the attack and has the upper hand making Gd's intervention more necessary. The Rebbe analogizes this physical battle with the battle against our *yetzer ha'rah* – if you do not give habit to deleterious actions, then compulsions are easier to overcome; but, if you allow bad habits to become a routine part of you then their defeat is much more difficult.

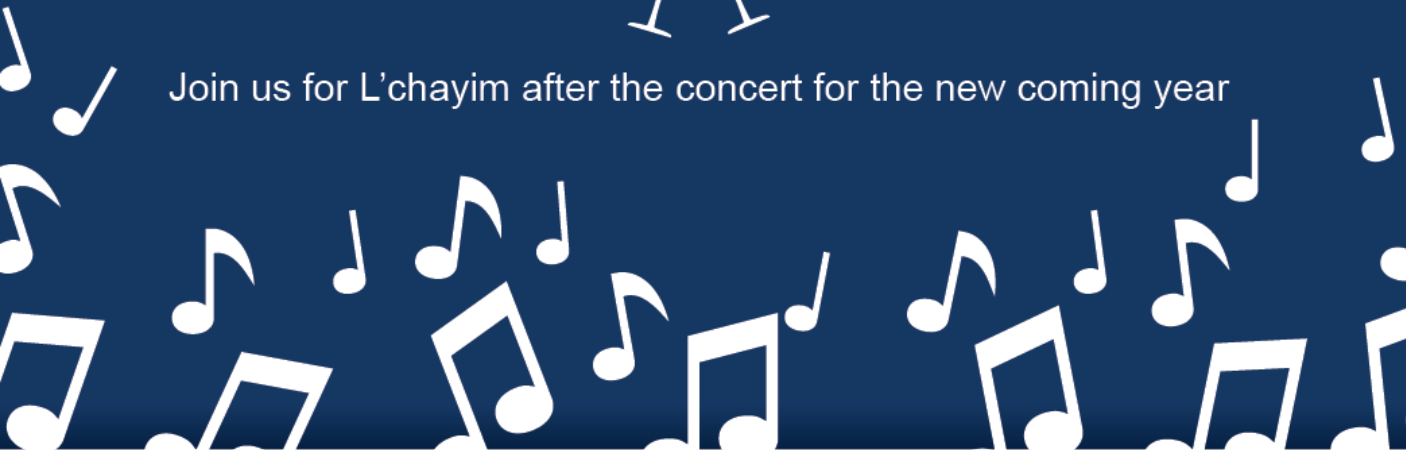
