## Sisterhood Report for the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year

The members of Temple Beth Shalom's Sisterhood are a diverse group who join together for friendship and study, to further the goals of our synagogue, and to reach into the community for tikkun olam—the repair of the world. Sisterhood creates an atmosphere for members to fulfill their potential within a Jewish arena.

Sisterhood sponsors b'nai mitzvah candidates by giving each one a personal yad they can use to read the Torah and keep afterwards. We have done this for years and continue to do so to support the temple.

Sisterhood donates funds annually to camp scholarships and rabbis' discretionary funds and music funds, to be used for the greater Temple Beth Shalom community.

Looking ahead, in February 2024, we will host our annual Sisterhood retreat in Wimberly, TX which typically draws 50-plus people for a relaxing weekend getaway.

- October 15...Over 35 congregants joined Sisterhood and Brotherhood for Sangria in the Sukkah! Everyone brought a dish to share and we supplied sangria and other beverages.
- September 18... Sisterhood coffee and schmooze meeting at Tous Les Jours bakery.
- September 11...Sisterhood and Brotherhood had a happy hour at Juliet Italian Kitchen.
