YAHRZEIT PLAQUE ORDER FORM



Losing loved ones is one of life's most difficult experiences. While they live on in our own personal memory, some of us seek ways to honor them with a more tangible memorial.

Purchasing a Yahrzeit Plaque for display in our sanctuary is a wonderful opportunity to further – and permanently – honor the memory of your loved one. Each 2" x 8" plaque is brushed aluminum with printed black text. It can contain up to 3 lines that would include your loved one's English name; their Hebrew name, if known; and their Secular and transliterated Hebrew dates of death. If you do not know the Hebrew date of death, we will look it up for you.

The format of a 3-line plaque is shown below.

Individual Yahrzeit Plaques are available for \$360, and will be permanently mounted on the Yahrzeit Memorial Wall in our sanctuary. Spaces on the Wall may also be ordered (reserved) at the same time so that all your loved ones can have their plaques near each other.

Plaques will be illuminated during the week of your loved one's Yahrzeit, as well as during the four Yahrzeit services during the year (Yom Kippur, Sukkot, Shavuot, and Passover).

Memorializing your loved one in a place of ongoing Jewish life and learning is a beautiful way to honor their memory.
