This blessing is said the first time you enter the Sukkah this year:

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of all, for giving us life, for sustaining us, and for enabling us to reach this season.

Blessing for dwelling in the Sukkah:

Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech haolam, asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav vitzivanu leisheiv basukah. בָּרוּדְ אַתָּה יְיָ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶדְ הָעוֹלָם,אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשְׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו, וְצִוֵּנוּ לֵישֵׁב בַּסֻּכָּה.

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of all, who has sanctified us through Your commandments and commanded us to sit in the sukkah.

Blessing for waving the lulav:

Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech haolam, asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav vitzivanu al n'tilat lulav. בָּרוּדְ אַתָּה יְיָ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶדְ הָעוּלָם,אֲשֶׁר קִדְשְׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו, וְצִוָּנוּ עַל נְטִילַת לוּלָב.

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of all, who has sanctified us through Your commandments and commanded us concerning the taking of the palm branch.
