Beth El's Women of Reform Judaism (BE-WRJ) is committed to Women, our Congregation and to Judaism. We serve our Synagogue, the Community, and the Jewish World.

## What do your membership dues pay for?

- Our children: Each year we make generous contributions to the religious school and other Jewish youth programs. At Beth El we support the Madrachim Program, provide gifts for Bar/Bat Mitzvah/Confirmands, and opportunities for youth to gain their needed service hours and acquire leadership skills.
- Our Beth El community: We coordinate onegs and Bimah flowers for b'nai mitzvot, and manage the Judaica Shop and boutiques for Hanukkah and Pesach. We also make a significant contribution to the Beth El operating budget.
- Our members: We provide special-interest activities such as knitting club, Hanukkah social, Mah Jongg, Book Club, and other day and evening activities. All current, paid-up members receive a 10% discount on their qualifying Judaica Shop purchases.
- Our Rabbinic and cantorial students nationwide: Through the WRJ national organization, we support education for America's future congregational leaders.
- Our Cultural and religious programming. We schedule book clubs, interfaith events, speakers, Women's Seder, and annual WRJ Shabbat Service, and decorate the sukkah on the bimah.
- Our Community and Social Action projects: We support local Jewish organizations including the George Mason Hillel and National Federation of Temple Youth; and we engage in community social action through tutoring at local schools, cooking and serving meals at the Carpenter's Shelter in Alexandria, and support of Friends of Guest House.
- **YES Fund** (Youth, Education, and Special Projects) represents the collective financial efforts of our member sisterhoods and donors to strengthen the institutions of our Reform Movement and ensure the future of Reform Judaism.
