### Saturday, August 28 • Selichot Service

**Selichot Service** held in the sanctuary, 9:00pm (*Streaming option available*)

### Monday, September 6 • Erev Rosh Hashanah WELCOME HOME

**Erev Rosh Hashanah Service** held in the sanctuary, 8:00pm (*Streaming option available*)

- All members attending must provide proof of vaccination; masks are required; seating will be socially distanced between households)

### Tuesday, September 7 • Rosh Hashanah First Day Services

**Morning Service** held in the sanctuary, 10:00am (*Streaming option available*)

- All members attending must provide proof of vaccination; masks are required; seating will be socially distanced between households.

**Family Service** held outdoors, 2:30--4:00pm, first 45 minutes are targeted to younger children up to age five; second 45 minutes are targeted to children ages 5-12

- Masks are required for all including children ages three and older; seating will be socially distanced between households. All members 12 and over who attend must provide proof of vaccination.

**Tashlich Service** held at North Hempstead Beach Park (Bar Beach), 5:00pm
