**Important reminders: Please read each of the reminders below and check the boxes (online version: enter an x) to assent**

- Proper attire must be worn by all who ascend. Men: Jacket. Women: modest attire (not overly brief or revealing), head covering/no purse while at the bima.
- Guests must observe proper decorum in the synagogue: No talking in the sanctuary, no smoking, photography or cellphone usage on Shabbat.
- Honorees should be properly prepared: Those with aliyot must know the blessings. Those with readings should review them in advance.
- Make sure all honorees are seated in the sanctuary in time for their honors. The Torah service begins around 9:30 AM.
- Packages and gifts should not be brought in or out of the synagogue on Shabbat.
