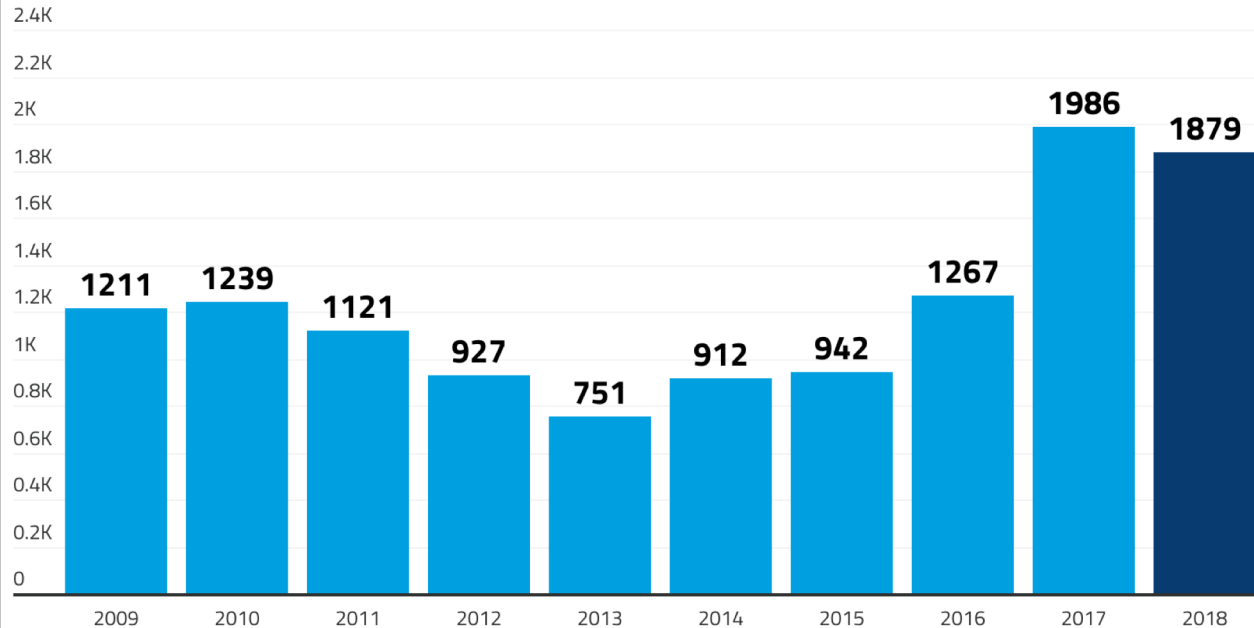

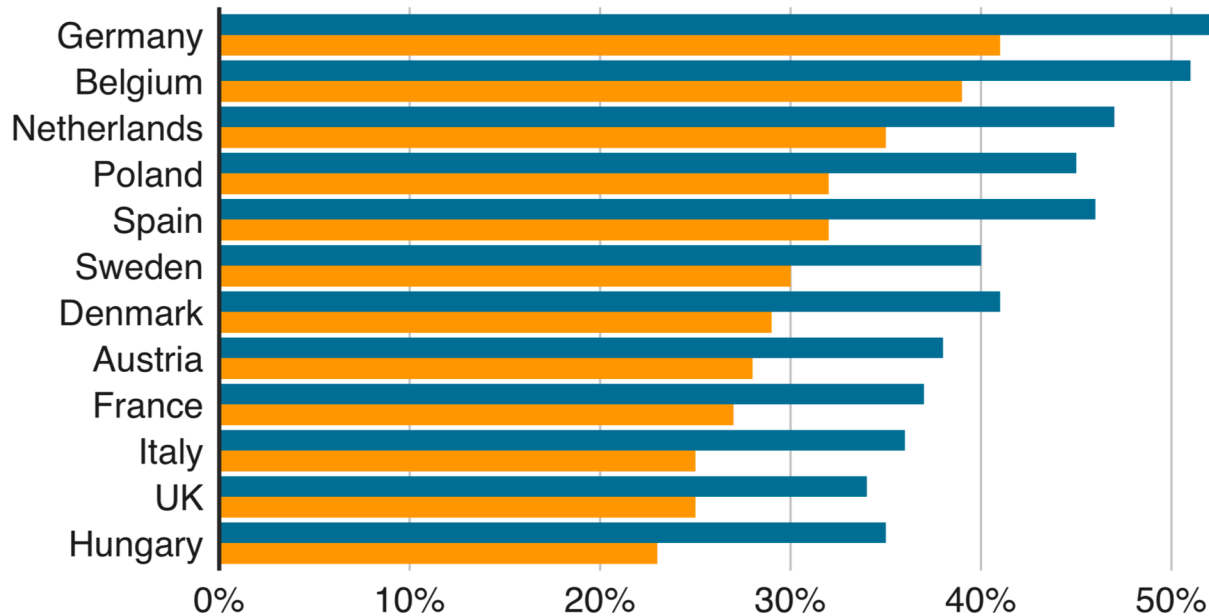

% of respondents who have been offended or threatened

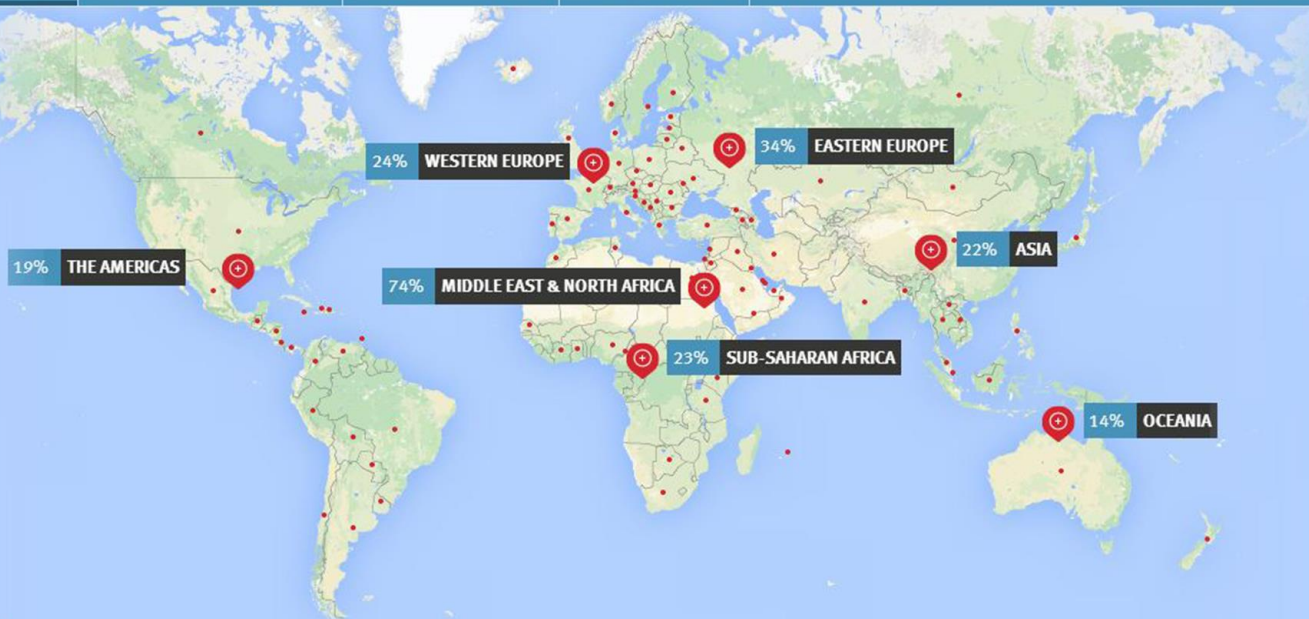

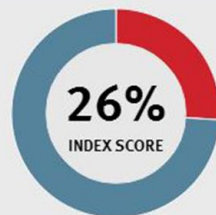

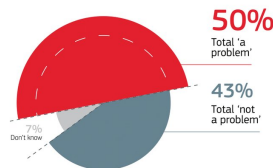

THE PERCEPTION OF ANTISEMITISM AS A PROBLEM

Every other European considers antisemitism as a problem in their country. 4 in 10 Europeans consider it not to be an issue in their country.

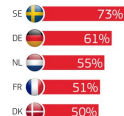
IS THE PROBLEM GETTING WORSE?

Only slightly over a third of Europeans perceive an increase in antisemitism. Close to two thirds do not perceive an increase.

The share of "don't know" answers outweighs the share of "has decreased".



In five countries, at least half of the population think that antisemitism has increased



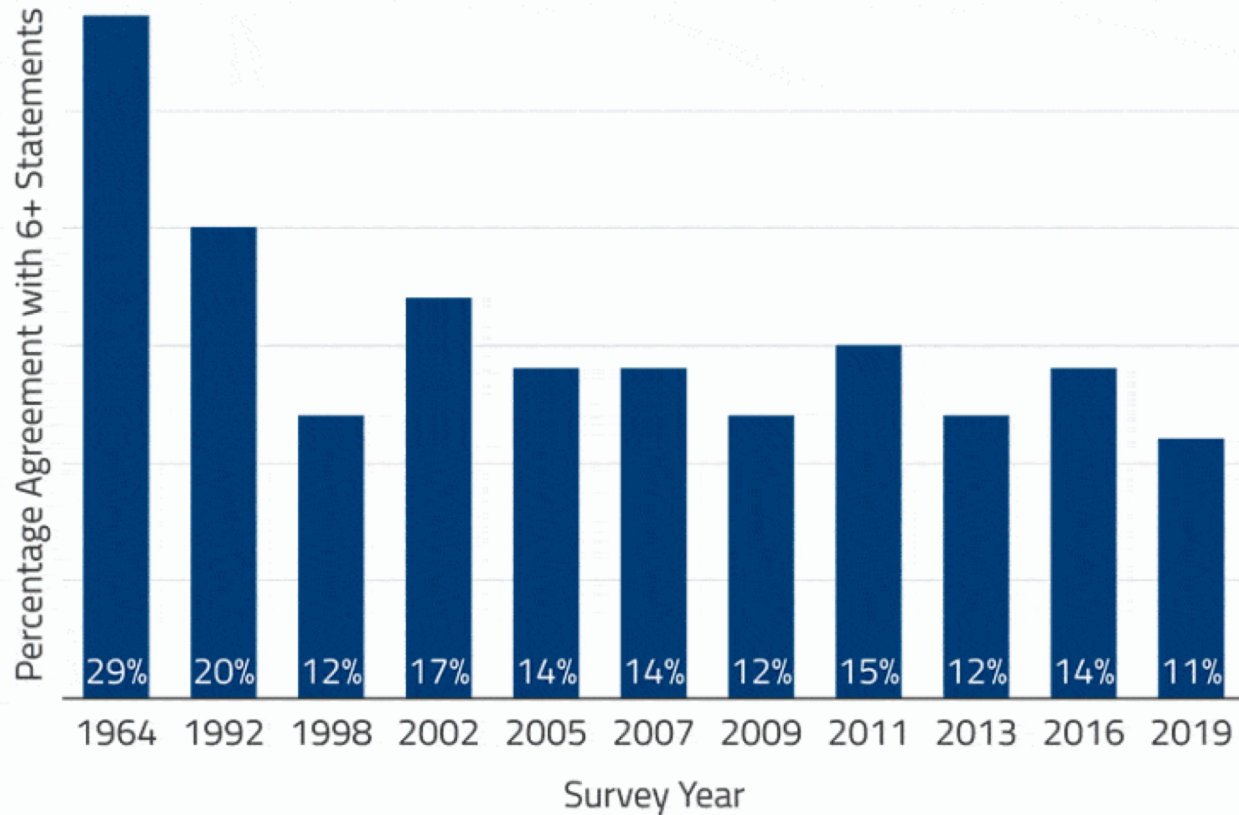

Nearly half

of the respondents worried about being subjected to anti-Semitic verbal insults or harassment (**47%**), and **four in 10** worried about an anti-Semitic physical attack (**40%**).

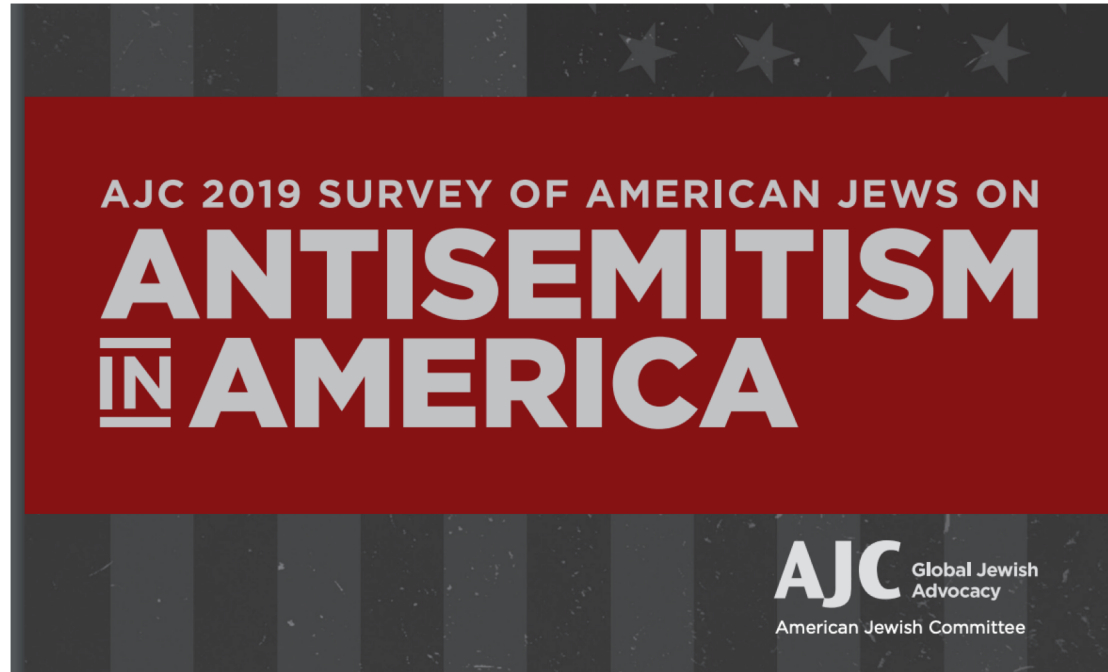


Those who wear, carry, or display items in public that could identify them as Jewish are subject to more anti-Semitic harassment (**37%**) than those who do not (**21%**).

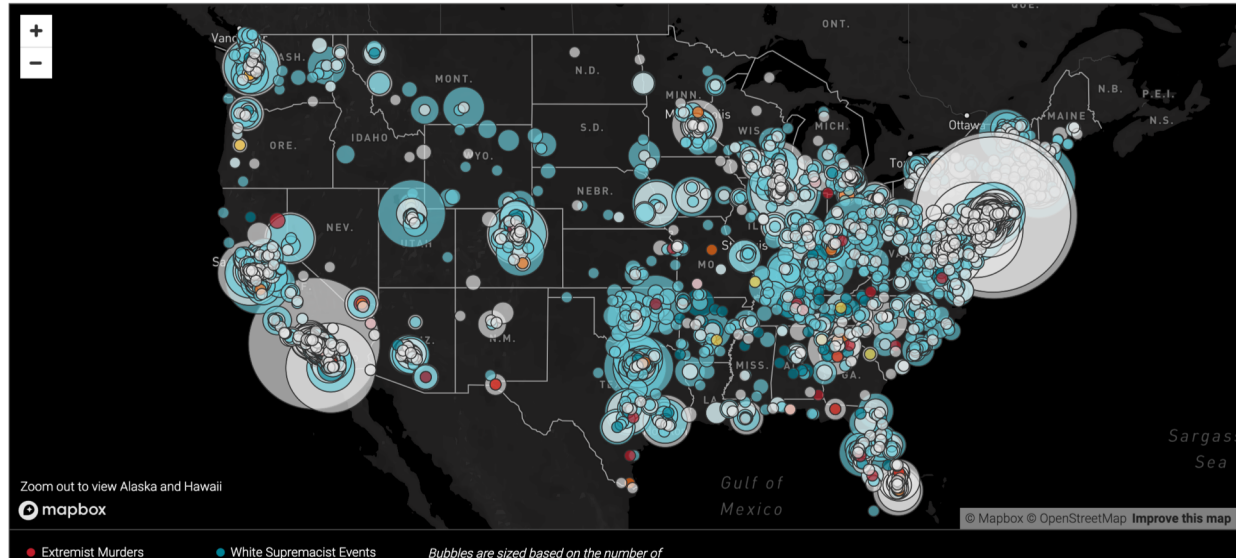

In 2018 and 2019, there were **7,743** incidents of extremism or anti-Semitism in the United States.

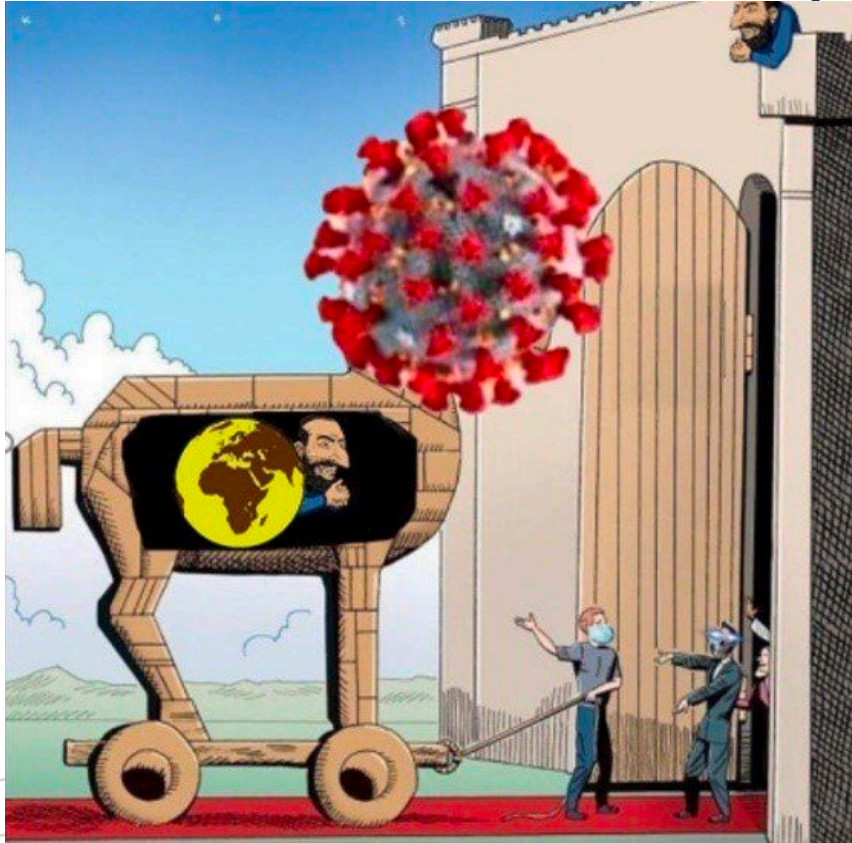
