





An 'Ob originally referred to a pit from which a ghost would emerge. This was an ancient practice in the Near East and Asia Minor.
The ghost ritual took piace at right.
An animal was scarfficed in the pit, and/or its blood poured into the pit. The was the bait for the ghost. In some casse loaves of bread and silver ears were an in some casse loaves of bread and silver ears were

also added to the pit.

Only later did the word 'Ōb come to mean "a medium," or "the dead spirit being summoned," and the memory of the pit was lost.




Medieval Images of Saul and the Medium of Endor





