

Ticket Information 5784/2023

MEMBER TICKETS

As part of Olam Tikvah membership, tickets to all High Holiday services are included for each household member including children over the age of 6 years and under 25 years as of January 1, 2023, or who are full-time students. Each family member will receive a ticket, and admission to services is only for the member named and not transferable.

GUEST TICKETS

Members may obtain tickets for guests at a cost \$60 per person for the holiday period including Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Guests are defined as:

- Children 25 years or older as of January 1, 2023
- Married children and their spouses (regardless of age and location)
- Anyone who lives outside the Washington Metro area
- Parents of members who live with members; or
- Parents of members who live outside the Washington Metro area

*Military personnel and full-time college or graduate students may receive tickets at no charge upon presentation of their ID.

NON-MEMBER TICKETS:

Family members and friends who live within the Washington Metro area who do not match the above criteria can request tickets at a cost of

- \$500/adult aged 25 years and older and
- \$65/child aged 13 24 years (children under 13 years old are free).

*Military personnel and full-time college or graduate students may receive tickets at no charge upon presentation of their ID.

RECIPROCITY

Out-of-town guests who are members in good standing of a congregation affiliated with United Synagogue may request courtesy tickets. Their congregation must send, fax, or email Melissa Benson a letter stating they are members in good standing and will not be attending High Holy Day Services at their home synagogue.

Associate members may also request reciprocity tickets with proof of membership at another area synagogue.
