
## FILLYOUR SEDER PLATE



**OBJECT OF GAME:** To collect the five objects that go on the Seder plate

MATERIALS NEEDED: 1 game board


1 "Fill The Seder Plate" paper per player


1 die


1 pawn per player crayons or markers

TO PLAY: Give each player one Seder plate paper. Each player selects a pawn and places it on any "START". The first player rolls the die and moves clockwise the number of spaces indicated. If the player lands on an object and does not have that object, then the player colors that object on the player's Seder plate paper. When a player has "filled their Seder plate", he/she is the winner. (Optional: Players may move either clockwise or counter clockwise to make it easier to land on the object they need.)



## FILL YOUR SEDER PLATE



Glue this sheet to back of file/construction paper folder. Make copies of this sheet to play game.

## Assembly Directions for FILL YOUR SEDER PLATE

Print game sheets on copy paper. Cut around the outside edge of the border on the title page. Glue title page on the front of a file folder or on an 11" x 17" piece of construction paper folded in half. Cut off dotted line strips on the two game board sheets and glue the sheets inside of the file folder or folded construction paper. Leave a small space between the two inside sheets so the game board will fold. Laminate the game board. Trim the laminate around the game board. Make copies of the black and white seder plate sheet.
