Our tradition records this even for posterity as it paints the image of a great man. While the rest of the nation is preparing itself for the exodus from Egypt with packing and plundering the wealth of Egypt (later understood as back payment for the years of slavery given without pay! – biblical support for war reparations) Moshe has none of this. Not concerned for himself or the wealth of his family Moses lovingly searches out the burial place of Joseph – and fulfills the earlier promise to not leave him behind. The promise to carry his remains for reinternment in the Land of Israel.
