RABBI'S SHABBAT MESSAGE

"These are the records of the Tabernacle, the Tabernacle of the Pact, which were drawn up at Moses' bidding—the work of the Levites under the direction of Ithamar son of Aaron the priest."

As the Book of Exodus draws to a close so too does the exhaustive outline of how the Mishkan was to be built. Item upon item is detailed. Amounts are tallied. The individuals responsible for this task or that task is given to us as well. Which led Jewish tradition to wonder why? Why tell us all this, why the detail, why the need to know?

To which the answers all ultimately lead to a single conclusion: places of religion are not like businesses. Yes, there are bills to pay. Moses in detailing all the work is telling us transparency is the root of honesty.


